

Abortion Care Network (ACN) is seeking a Technical Assistance (TA) Program Manager. The TA Program Manager oversees the planning, implementation, and evaluation of the Technical Assistance Program for ACN clinic members. The TA Program Manager is the central point of contact for ACN abortion providers and ally members' technical assistance needs. TA works to provide targeted support to help implement solutions that members face. This position can be fully remote or hybrid remote/in-person in Minneapolis, Minnesota. This role is a full-time, exempt position and reports to the Membership Co-Director. Travel is required up to 8 times per year for site visits or conferences.

Salary range: \$78,300 - \$83,800 ACN salary bands are determined by an organizational pay equity process. Unlike market-based compensation systems, ACN's pay equity process focuses on the level of responsibility each employee holds in their position. The process has been developed to ensure integrity, equity and transparency in setting salaries across the organization and embodies ACN's values. This range represents the lowest and highest this position may score using our pay equity rubric based on the qualifications you bring to this position. ACN incorporates a geographical score in determining compensation as part of the pay equity process. As a national organization, this score is in recognition that some areas of the country are significantly more expensive to live. The geographic score is \$0-\$5,000 in addition to the salary range.

**Benefits include**: Health insurance including medical, vision, dental, and life insurance paid 100%, every other Friday off, 25 days PTO annually, 12 paid holidays, 401k and HSA contributions, cell phone and home internet reimbursement, and professional development stipend. Employees may add dependents to health and dental coverage, and ACN will cover half the premium costs of qualified dependents.

# **Duties:**

### Member Relations

- Prioritizes the needs and sustainability of ACN member clinics.
- Responds to requests for analysis, interpretation, and/or deductions from presented facts or circumstances to determine the appropriate assistance, internally and externally.
  - Regular outreach to ACN members is conducted to gather feedback on relevant issues and communicate trends to ACN staff.
  - Manage and update ACN network communications.
  - Develop Technical Assistance guidance for clinic members on timely and relevant topics.

- Develop a Technical Assistance program based on member requests, trends, and strategic goals.
- Grows and maintains connections and collaborations with ACN ally members who provide technical assistance services to clinic members.
- Participates in conference-related activities, including attending the annual conference, pre-conference meetings, on-site support throughout the entire conference, and post-conference activities.
- Provides onsite support at ACN membership events, including the annual meeting, membership gatherings, board meetings, and staff meetings.
- Manage ongoing membership meetings on topics affecting abortion care at micro and macro levels.
- Represents ACN members and ACN in movement spaces. Attends related meetings, calls, and planning sessions as required. Travel and/or virtual.

## Operations and Processes

- Develops, manages, and implements a yearly work plan for ACN's Technical Assistance (TA) Program that meets strategic program outcomes and goals.
- Maintain TA program systems with a centralized, transparent, defined process that centers ACN's mission, vision, and values.
- Responsible for managing ACN's Resource Library and tracking ACN's internally developed tools and resources for staff and members in a centralized index and external resources for TA staff referrals
- Responsible for managing implementation and reporting on program goals, which are monitored through program evaluation, tracking, and member follow-up.
- Works closely with staff within the ACN membership department and staff across the organization to ensure continuity of programming, referrals, strategic goals, and successful outcomes.

This is not an exhaustive list of duties, though these are the general tasks that comprise this job.

- A minimum of 3 years abortion clinic experience in a management role
- Comfort with digital communication (Zoom) and using remote work tools to move projects forward
- Proficiency in using a computer to perform work-related tasks. Familiarity with Google Suites, collaborative file storage systems, and work organization systems like Asana.
- Great written and oral meeting-based communication skills
- Reliable with swift response and communication time
- Strong project management, time management, and planning skills, with a demonstrated ability to take the initiative and drive projects forward independently
- A personal and professional commitment to ongoing development in anti-racist and equity-centered communication
- Previous experience working with independent abortion care providers preferred
